White Lake Resources Corporation (WLRC) is inviting applications for upcoming vacancies on our Board of Directors, including:

- Directors (5 positions)
- Youth Advisor (1 position)
- Elder Advisor (1 position)

WLRC is the general partner for the White Lake Limited Partnership (WLLP) and oversees the partnership's day-to-day management. WLRC is governed by a board of directors that employs a staff team to run the business.

White Lake LP is Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg's principal business and delivers a wide range of business services mainly within the Traditional Homelands of the Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg, including Moberg. The board's principal role is to govern the corporation. Directors must always act in the corporation's best interests, and they are expected to do so in good faith and with sound business judgment.

Under the Ontario Corporations Act, to be a director of a corporation, a person must be at least 18 years of age, of sound mind, and not in a state of undischarged bankruptcy.

The WLRC board would benefit from members who also:

- Are a member of the Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg (residing on or off reserve);
- Are willing to participate as a member of a team of directors and contribute in a positive manner to the management and growth of WLLP, including maintaining confidentiality;
- Be prepared to represent WLRC and WLLP positively within the community and membership;
- Be willing to complete director training and thereafter comply with applicable laws, policies and procedures, including WLLP policies;
- Be available to attend regularly scheduled (typically monthly) meetings, including in person in Mobert, occasionally Sault Ste. Marie and Thunder Bay, and online via Teams – meetings are typically held in afternoons or early evenings during weekdays, although there is an annual weekend workshop for business planning;
- Be able to dedicate the time to review board packages and correspondence between board meetings and respond to emails and phone calls on a timely basis;
- Have access to a computer, phone and a reliable internet connection;
- Be ready to commit to a 3-year term
- Have education, experience and/or working knowledge in one or more of the following fields:
 - Business
 - Economic Development
 - Finance
 - Human Resources
 - Mining
 - Forestry
 - Construction
 - Waste Management
 - Health and Safety

The Youth and Elder Advisors are non-voting members of the Board.

The principal purpose of the Youth Advisor is to be the voice of youth at the board table, and to build their experience and capacity to contribute to corporate governance in the future.

The purpose of the Elder Advisor is to provide wisdom and guidance to the board from a traditional, cultural and spiritual perspective.

The principal of the Employees of WLLP, WLRC or any of its related companies is not eligible to apply.

Directors and Advisors are appointed by way of a BCR of the Council of the Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg and are paid an honorarium plus expenses.
