The Medical Van Driver is responsible for providing safe, reliable, and respectful transportation for community members attending medical appointments and accessing health-related services. The successful candidate must be dependable, professional, and able to work flexible hours, including overnight trips and weekends when scheduled.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely transport clients to and from medical appointments and other approved health-related services.
- Follow assigned transportation schedules and promptly communicate any delays, changes, or concerns.
- Maintain regular communication with the Health Manager and designated Health Centre staff.
- Conduct and document daily vehicle inspections before operating any assigned vehicle.
- Report vehicle damage, mechanical concerns, safety issues, or required maintenance immediately.
- Maintain the cleanliness and general condition of Health Centre vehicles.
- Assist clients entering and exiting the vehicle when appropriate and safe to do so.
- Protect client privacy and maintain confidentiality at all times.
- Follow all applicable traffic laws, workplace health and safety requirements, transportation procedures, and organizational policies.
- Adhere to the Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg Code of Conduct.
- Complete transportation records, mileage logs, inspection forms, and other required documentation.
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Health Manager.

Qualifications

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent is required.
- Must possess a valid Ontario Class G driver's license.
- Must provide a satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Previous experience providing transportation services is considered an asset.
- Experience working with clients, patients, Elders, or community members is

considered an asset.

- Strong communication, time-management, and organizational skills.
- Ability to follow schedules, instructions, policies, and safety procedures.
- Ability to work independently and respond professionally to unexpected changes or delays.
- Must be reliable, respectful, and committed to providing safe and confidential service.

Conditions of Employment

- Ability and willingness to work flexible hours, including evenings, overnight trips, weekends, and holidays when scheduled.
- Successful completion of a pre-employment drug test.
- Successful completion of a Criminal Record Check, including a Vulnerable Sector Check.
- Continued possession of a valid Ontario Class G driver's license and an acceptable driving record.
- Compliance with all Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg policies, procedures, and standards of conduct.
