Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg is seeking reliable and dedicated Fishery Defenders to ensure the protection and security of our fishery resources. The position is responsible for monitoring access to fishery areas, reporting to enforcement agencies, and working closely with community leadership to maintain a safe environment. This is a 4-week term offering an essential service to safeguard our traditional practices and ensure compliance with local fishery laws.

Key Responsibilities:

- Monitor access to fishery areas.
- Documentation and reporting to senior officials.
- Work with other security personnel and law enforcement agencies to maintain a safe environment.
- Respond to emergencies and provide assistance as needed.

Qualifications:

- Excellent attention to detail and observation skills
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Experience in security, law enforcement, or fishery defense preferred.
- Knowledge of fishery laws and Indigenous fishing rights is an asset.
- Physically capable of lifting up to 50lbs.
- Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
- Performing patrol duties in varying weather conditions on land and water.
- Valid First Aid/CPR would be an asset.
- Possess a Class G Driver's License and access to a reliable vehicle
- Possess a Pleasure Craft Operators Card (PCOC) or equivalent.
