- Experience working in or with First Nation communities is preferred;
- Strong understanding of Indigenous culture, governance and community safety priorities;
- Experience in managing incidents and emergencies (ICS training is considered an asset);
- Strong investigative, report writing and communication skills;
- Experience working with vulnerable populations and applying de-escalation techniques;
- Ability to pass a Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector check.
