Reporting to the Operations Manager of White Lake LP, and ultimately the Director of Operations, the Garbage Truck Operator will be responsible for the collection/disposal of waste, operation of the garbage truck and operation and maintenance of the waste transfer station.

This position is based in Mobert, Ontario.

Responsibilities:

- Reports to the Operations Manager
- Pick up and transportation of waste from residential and commercial buildings including loading waste materials into disposal bins and truck
- Operate garbage truck including driving along local pickup routes and to the waste disposal site at White River.
- Monitor and maintain the waste transfer station
- Conduct daily inspections of vehicle and equipment and complete routine preventative maintenance and repair work, including related record keeping
- Complete all related training and certification
- Performs other related duties as required

Abilities:

- Ability to work cooperatively with a wide variety of people
- Ability to supervise subordinate staff (labourers)
- Ability to follow instructions independently
- Ability to do physical labor; lift at least 40lbs on a repetitive basis
