CLARIFICATION ON NEW MEASURES:

There have been a few requests for clarification on the changes to our pandemic rules posted yesterday:

- A non-resident family member must be the immediate family of the resident that they are visiting;
- An immediate family member is defined as a parent; sibling; child by blood, adoption, or marriage; spouse; grandparent or grandchild;
- For example, if you live in Marathon, you can visit your brother who lives in Mobert but the non-resident's children cannot;
- We are not open for non-residents who do not have immediate family living in Mobert. (Essential service providers are permitted but must be approved by the Appeals Committee in advance).

Please remember that our by-law remains full in force and effect including:

- 1. All persons entering Mobert will continue to be required to complete the entry screening questionnaire and fever testing.
- 2. All persons who enter the Pic Mobert Reserve must adhere to social distancing by keeping a minimum of 6' between themselves and any other person, except persons within their immediate household or family.
- 3. All persons must wear a non-medical mask when they will or potentially will come into close contact with a person without social distancing, including entering and moving around any building that is owned and operated by the Pic Mobert First Nation.
- 4. There shall be no group gatherings of more than 5 people (this is Ontario law).

These conditions are being reviewed weekly and may change further again next week. Please watch for updated.
